

Bo Price was born in England and grew up in the USA, attending Harvard University. He has been active as a pianist, coach, and accompanist for over 40 years. As a répétiteur, he has worked throughout Europe, including at least eight years each at the Teatro dell'Opera in Rome, Oper Leipzig, and Gärtnerplatztheater in Munich; as well as for shorter stints at the Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia (Rome), Maggio Musicale Fiorentino (Florence), and Orchestra Haydn (Bolzano), in Italy; the Theater St. Gallen and Opernhaus Zürich in Switzerland; the Bregenzer Festspiele and Salzburg Mozarteum in Austria, and the Theater Halle, Theater Regensburg, and Landestheater Niederbayern in Germany. He has collaborated with conductors such as Nello Santi, Riccardo Chailly, Bruno Campanella, Donato Renzetti, Marco Armiliato, Gianluigi Gelmetti, Christopher Hogwood, Anthony Bramall, Ulf Schirmer, Axel Kober, and Mstislav Rostropovich. Bo Price has taught at the "Maggio Musicale Formazione" (Florence), "Fondazione Musica per Roma" (Rome) in Italy; and the Felix Mendelssohn-Bartholdy Hochschule für Musik und Theater (Leipzig), and Sächsische Sängerkademie (Torgau) in Germany. He is also active as a Lied pianist, piano accompanist for vocal competitions, and Italian pronunciation coach.
